The idea that orchids are difficult to grow and only for the wealthy is just a myth Many orchids can easily be grown in the typical Alaskan home. The growing conditions for most easily acquired orchids are relatively straightforward--a simple matter of suitable light, water, temperature and humidity.

Many orchids can be purchased inexpensively and may be grown without sophisticated equipment. Windowsills and areas with good light exposure will work for many species. If you can bloom an African Violet you can grow and bloom *Phalaenopsis, Paphiopedilums, Miltonias* and *Masdevallias*. Cool- and intermediate-growing types can be placed outdoors for the Alaskan summer to help initiate blooms.

There are over 30,000 orchid species and many more hybrids. Alaska has 32 native species. Orchids are found on every continent except Antarctica.
